

Skier criteria:

- Current GWSC member
- Able to deep water start and cross the wakes on 1 or 2 skis
- Able to deep water start on a trick ski, wakeboard or kneeboard

Details:


- Free entry
- Sunday 10/11/24
- 8am start (start list/times will be distributed the day before)
- All ages welcome
- Each skier will have one "slalom" and one "trick"
- This event will occur with modified competition rules to increase enjoyment
- Skiers will start from the start dock on the jump block
- Viewing spots will be from the club house for slalom and the jump dock for trick
- Presentations will happen after the last skier has finished

Helpful tips:

- The driver will ask what speed you would like, think about what speed works best for you in kilometres per hour
- If you would like to use your own handle, please bring this with you (especially if you need a big V handle)
- Bring your own equipment to use including skis and lifejackets, some club equipment will be available if needed

Slalom:

- The skier can ride either 1 or 2 skies for this event
- The skier will get 4 passes through the slalom course
- On their 4th pass the skier can ski back to the clubhouse or if the skier falls the pick up boat will bring them back to the club house
- Scoring:
 - There are 6 turns in the course, the wider a skier is at these turns the more points they will get
 - Skiing around an outer course buoy will gain 10 points
 - Skiing around an inner course buoy will gain 5 points
 - Skiing around the boat guides will be 2 points
 - \circ $\;$ Gates will not be judged and the skier can continue scoring if they miss a turn



Trick:

- The skier can ride either a trick ski, a wake board or a knee board for this event
- The skier will get 2 passes through the slalom course
- On their 2nd pass the skier can ski back to the dock or the boat will pick them up if they fall
- Scoring:

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- \circ $\;$ Each pass starts on the skiers first trick and will end after 20 seconds
- Each trick can be completed a second time in the opposite direction (or waving hand)
- Repeated tricks will not be scored
 - Tricks and points include:
 - Waving 10 points
 - Crossing the wake 20 points
 - Side slide (90deg turn) 40 points
 - Back (180deg turn) 60 points
 - Front (180deg turn) 60 points
 - O (360deg turn) 90 points
